The world characterizes the controversy between Creation and Evolution as a conflict between religion and science – it is actually a conflict between two different worldviews. Come and find out <u>why</u>.

When we look at scientific evidence in three different areas of science: 1) taxonomy, 2) origin of man, and 3) origin of life, we conclude that science supports Creation much better than Evolution. Dr. Heinz Lycklama earned a Ph. D. degree in Nuclear Physics from McMaster University in Canada and has worked in the telecommunications and computer software industries for over forty years. He has taught through many books of the Bible and has served as member and Chairman of various Missions Committees as well as Elder/Deacon Boards.

Challenged in his Christian faith by what he was taught in university in the 1960's, Heinz later developed a series of lectures on <u>Creation vs. Evolution</u> and <u>Christian Apologetics</u> over the years and presented the material in Sunday school classes, to college students, during church services, at Bible Schools, and other venues in Europe, Asia and North America. The Apologetics Forum of Snohomish County (AFSC)

Dr. Heinz Lycklama and **Mr. Rob Overgaard** formed the **Apologetics Forum of Snohomish County (AFSC)** to help equip Christians in the defense of their faith in the postmodern world in three related areas: 1) <u>Creation vs. Evolution</u>, 2) <u>Christian Apologetics</u> and 3) <u>Biblical Worldview</u>. **AFSC** provides a local Forum in the North Snohomish County area for lectures and DVD programs by knowledgeable presenters on these topics. All presentations are given with the presupposition that the Bible is God's inspired Word and is accurate and inerrant in its original autographs. The Bible is a total worldview that speaks to all disciplines and areas of our life.

Studies done by <u>Answers In Genesis (AIG</u>), documented in the books <u>Already Gone</u> and <u>Already Compromised</u>, show that more than 60% of youth raised in the church leave the church once they leave home. The main reasons are 1) they are looking for more answers to their hard questions, and 2) they are being indoctrinated in secularism and evolutionism. See also this <u>Koinonia House article</u>.

Monthly <u>AFSC</u> meetings will be held at a church in the North Snohomish County area. Each meeting will include a lecture or the showing of a DVD on a topic within the scope of the Forum's mission. There will be time for discussion on the topic presented, followed by refreshments.

<u>AFSC</u> creates a Forum where Christians can learn from each other, ask the hard questions about our Faith, Creation and Worldview, and receive the support of a community of Christian thinkers. The Forum equips Christians with well-researched information on issues that seek to challenge the truth of Christianity as revealed in the Bible.
