This documentary film premiered at Missions Fest Seattle 2012 and was produced by Mark Champneys with **Saints Alive In Jesus**, a counter-cult and apologetics ministry. The film demonstrates that Evolution is impossible according to the many good questions that brilliant evolutionists cannot answer. Creation Ministries International (CMI) launched the Question Evolution campaign in 2012 to expose Evolution's

fatal weaknesses, and is building on this with the release of a book and documentary called Evolution's Achilles'
Heels in early 2014. The Evolution
Demolition film points out many of the fatal weaknesses in Evolution using terms and graphics easily understood by the layperson. The film challenges the viewer



to ask the basic question - is this fact or speculation? It makes the distinction between micro-evolution and macro-evolution, information and random mutations, accident and purpose, design and chance, and simple and complex organisms to show that Evolution has <u>never</u> been observed, <u>is not</u> occurring now, and indeed <u>cannot</u> happen.

Mark Champneys was born a 5th generation Mormon, the son of an LDS bishop. Now a believer, he is lay Evangelism Director with Saints Alive and a Fair Ministry Coordinator with Child Evangelism Fellowship. The Apologetics Forum of Snohomish County (AFSC)

Dr. Heinz Lycklama and **Mr. Rob Overgaard** formed the **Apologetics Forum of Snohomish County (AFSC)** to help equip Christians in the defense of their faith in the postmodern world in three related areas: 1) <u>Creation vs. Evolution</u>, 2) <u>Christian Apologetics</u> and 3) <u>Biblical Worldview</u>. **AFSC** provides a local Forum in the North Snohomish County area for lectures and DVD programs by knowledgeable presenters on these topics. All presentations are given with the presupposition that the Bible is God's inspired Word and is accurate and inerrant in its original autographs. The Bible is a total worldview that speaks to all disciplines and areas of our life.

Studies done by <u>Answers In Genesis</u> (<u>AIG</u>), documented in the books <u>Already Gone</u> and <u>Already Compromised</u>, show that more than 60% of youth raised in the church leave the church once they leave home. The main reasons are 1) they are looking for more answers to their hard questions, and 2) they are being indoctrinated in secularism and evolutionism. See also this <u>Koinonia House article</u>.

Monthly <u>AFSC</u> meetings will be held at a church in the North Snohomish County area. Each meeting will include a lecture or the showing of a DVD on a topic within the scope of the Forum's mission. There will be time for discussion on the topic presented, followed by refreshments.

<u>AFSC</u> creates a Forum where Christians can learn from each other, ask the hard questions about our Faith, Creation and Worldview, and receive the support of a community of Christian thinkers. The Forum equips Christians with well-researched information on issues that seek to challenge the truth of Christianity as revealed in the Bible.

<u>AFSC</u> is run by a Board of Directors and advised by an Advisory Board whose members have knowledge in the topics discussed at <u>AFSC</u> meetings and have a strong interest in providing and supporting an environment for participants to gain well-researched information in the defense of their Christian faith.
