


War of the Worldviews: Christianity vs. Naturalism

It was widely claimed that science has undermined belief in Biblical miracles and the Biblical God. The myth is that objective, rational science is pitted against subjective, irrational religion. However, in science we must distinguish between hard observational data and subjective theory, which tries to explain the data. Scientific theory is very much worldview-driven.

Worldviews reflect our most basic presuppositions about reality. Which worldview should interpret the data? The war is really between naturalism and Christianity. The presuppositions of naturalism lead to a number of drastic implications, such as a denial of purpose. Naturalism has difficulty answering many basic questions about reality, such as the interactions between matter, mind, and math. The defense of naturalism is ultimately self-refuting. Christianity, on the other hand, gives coherence, meaning, purpose & hope.



[John Byl](#) has a Ph.D. in astronomy from the University of British Columbia. He is Professor Emeritus at Trinity Western University, Langley, BC, where he taught for over 30 years, and was chair of the department of Mathematical Sciences. He has written two books, *"God and Cosmos: A Christian View of Time, Space, and the Universe"* (2001) and *"The Divine Challenge: On Matter, Mind, Math, and Meaning"* (2004), as well as numerous articles on science, Christian worldview, and science/religion issues.
