


## **Debunking The Big Bang**

Was our Universe created by God, as described in the Bible? Or did it form itself in a Big Bang event, billions of years ago.


Secular scientists say that the Big Bang model is correct. But a closer examination reveals that this model is riddled with serious problems. It violates important

He worked for a number of years as an engineer in the US military space program. He entered that program as an atheist and an evolutionist, and left it as a creationist and a Christian. Today he speaks on creation/evolution, especially as it relates to astronomy. Spike has published two DVDs on the subject.
