#### **Before 1947:**


- earliest OT portions: ~AD 800
- more complete MSS: ~AD 980


#### Dead Sea Scrolls:


- copies now over 1000 years older
- word for word identical in more than 95% of the text other 5% is spelling variations, pen slips



ORIGINAL MANUSCRIPT











Copy 1: For the Son of man is come to ave that which was lost.

Copy 2: For the Son of man is come to sove that which was lost.

Copy 3: For the Son of man is come to sage that which was lost.

Copy 4: For the Son of man is come to sav that which was lost.

Original: For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.


The NT Documents Have <u>Far Fewer</u> Variations Than This Example


# we have an accurate copy of the original NT?

- 1. 43% of 8,000 NT verses in Manuscripts from 2nd Century
- Over 36,000 quotations from early church fathers
- 3. In addition to the 5,800+ Greek, there are over 19,000 manuscripts in other languages
- 4. Total manuscripts stack over a mile high (compared to 4 feet for classical Greek authors).

#### DANIEL 2

- 37 "You, O king, are a king of kings. For the God of heaven has given you a kingdom, power, strength, and glory;
- 38 "and wherever the children of men dwell, or the beasts of the field and the birds of the heaven, He has given them into your hand, and has made you ruler over them all--you are this head of gold.
- 39 "But after you shall arise another kingdom inferior to yours; then another, a third kingdom of bronze, which shall rule over all the earth.
- 49 "And the fourth kingdom shall be as strong as iron, inasmuch as iron breaks in pieces and shatters everything; and like iron that crushes, 45 that kingdom will break in pieces and crush all the others.
- 41 "Whereas you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; yet the strength of the iron shall be in it, just as you saw the iron mixed with

- 42 "And as the toes of the feet were partly of iron and partly of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong and partly fragile.
- 43 "As you saw iron mixed with ceramic clay, they will mingle with the seed of men; but they will not adhere to one another, just as iron does not mix with clay.
- 44 "And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and the kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever.
  - "Inasmuch as you saw that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it broke in pieces the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver, and the gold--the great God has made known to the king what will come to pass after this. The dream is certain, and its interpretation is sure."

- 46 Then King Nebuchadnezzar fell on his face, prostrate before Daniel, and commanded that they should present an offering and incense to him.
- 47 The king answered Daniel, and said, "Truly your God is the God of gods, the Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, since you could reveal this secret."






